Dear Families,  
Parenting is hard work. I know this firsthand as I have 4 children. Though they are grown now, I clearly remember how challenging it was to keep up with classroom news, signing reading logs, practicing for spelling tests, whose conference is which day etc. Fortunately, in the last couple of years, schools have really improved communication methods and make it easier for you to keep up. Here are some ways that you can stay informed at Shasta Meadows:

**Shasta Meadows website-** [shastameadows.eesd.net](http://shastameadows.eesd.net). This is an excellent source of information. Links like Calendar and Week at a Glance can help you know what time school starts and ends as well as important upcoming events like "Just Say No to Country Bowl". **Our district is launching a new website that we plan to roll out December 1<sup>st</sup> which will be even more informative and user-friendly.**

**Email-** all staff members have an email account which can be accessed through the school's website. On the left side of the home page, there is a tab called "School Staff". Click that link and then find the person's name and select it. This will link you to their classroom page. A link to create an email appears directly under the teacher's name.

**Marquee-** Located above the gym at the north entrance to the campus is our new marquee.

News and upcoming events flash every few seconds.

**Sunday Phone Message-** Each Sunday, I record a call that goes out to every student's primary home phone number. I try very hard to speak quickly and only share the most important items with you. If you aren't getting the Sunday call, please call the school so that we can update your phone number in the system. We can also arrange for the call to go to a second number if there is another household that would like the information.

**Tiger Folders-** All students were given a Tiger folder. Teachers use this as a primary method of getting class newsletters, homework and other important papers to home and back to school.

**Bloomz/Class Dojo-** Many teachers use a phone app to communicate upcoming events and information about your child's day. Ask your child's teacher if he or she uses one of these apps.

**Tiger Talk-** This newsletter is produced monthly. Copies are made and placed in your child's Tiger Folder. Additionally, we create a link to this newsletter on the school webpage.

**Facebook-** You can find us on Facebook at Shasta Meadows Elementary School.

Diarrhea




## Box Tops




## Lost and Found


